Founded in 1919, **Business and Professional Women (BPW/USA)** was the first national organization formed to promote equality for women in the workplace. In 2009, **BPW/USA** merged with the **BPW Foundation** (founded in 1956), and includes a network of over 12,000 workingwomen in hundreds of cities and towns across the country.

The **Maryland Federation (BPW/MD)**, founded in 1929, is a all-volunteer organization affiliated with local BPW organizations throughout the State. The Maryland Federation, consisting of six local organizations in the State, is a not-for profit, non-partisan, non-sectarian, self-governing and member supported organization. Our membership is diverse with administrators, teachers, business owners, secretaries, and many other professions.
